- Plan and support small outings, trips and other connections. for the summer day program
- Build and maintain relationship and supervise children during program activities, providing care to their physical, emotional, mental, spiritual and social needs.
- Complete research projects as assigned as part of the foundations leadership program.
- Report on attendance, stories, and feedback for each program activity
- Maintain proper documentation and strict confidentiality in accordance to Scott Mission policies

Required Experience and Education:

- Excellent verbal and written communication skills, including active listening
- Excellent interpersonal and conflict management skills
- Ability to multi-task and be flexible in daily routine
- Self-starter and result oriented, creative problem solver
- Team player with demonstrated flexibility and willingness to be mentored
